unto the said Lordship the said Proprietary in the Sum of twenty Pound Sterling Each for the
Use of the Inhabitants of Somerset County as to be levied upon his body, Goods or Chattels,
Lands or tenements ^{Severally} In Case they the said Alexander Maddox and Thomas Maddox their
heirs Executors or assigns or any of them do not from time to time and at all times hereafter acquit
discharge and Save harmless the Inhabitants of Somerset County as to from all sorts Charges and
troubles whatsoever for or by reason of the Birth, maintenance, Nurishment and bringing
up of the said Child, and of and from all ^{other} Suits Charges troubles and demands whatsoever
touching or concerning the same e^{t}
