Command you if you attach any the goods chattels rights or credits of Mary Esonne aduise
of all & Singular the goods chattels rights & credits of Benj^w. Esonne late of Somersett
County planter decd: if they shall be found in your Balywick to the value of twenty P.
curr. Money & eight hundred Pds of Tob^b: when you have the same so attached or any
part thereof the same in your custody safe keep so w^t you have them before the Justices
of our City Court to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of June next then & there
to be condemned according to act of Assembly to & for the use of a certain J^d. Esonne unless
the said Mary Esonne aduise as afo^r by herself or her atty shall appear and answer
unto the said J^d. Esonne in a plea of trespass upon the case & according to Law & that
by good & lawfull men of your Balywick you make known unto the person or per-
sons in whose hands you make the same attachment that he she or they be & appear
before the Justices of our City Court to be held as afo^r to shew cause if any he she or
they have why w^t same goods chattels rights or credits so attached in his her or their
hands Ought not to be condemned & executed hereof had & made according to the form of
the act of Assembly in such case made & provided if to him her or them it shall seem
