All the aforefoe and Celebora Taylor and Mary his wife Counterpart as afore by George Dashell their attorney  
come and defend the same and Injury when he and pray leave to Imparte Pierments unto the next Court  
and pay her it and the same day is given unto the aforefoe here also. —

At which said Next Court to witt the Nineteenth day of March and Dord. One thousand seven  
hundred and twenty eight Seven Comer againe as well the aforefoe James Martin and Mary his wife  
Counterpart as afore, as the aforefoe Mary Taylor Counterpart wife of the aforefoe Celebora Taylor Counterpart of  
the aforefoe William Bolitha by their attorney's afore, and the aforefoe James Martin and Mary his wife  
by their said attorney says (that the aforefoe Celebora Taylor, since the day of the continuall  
of the plea afore is dead &c. herespon against the aforefoe nothing further thereof is made &c.)  
that the cause of action afore doth surviv to them, against the aforefoe Mary Bolitha Counterpart as  
afore according to the form of the Statute in such case lately made and provided, herespon further  
day is given unto the aforefoe Mary Taylor Counterpart as afore unto the Next Court, to answer  
unto the aforefoe in the plea afore, and the aforefoe same day is given unto the aforefoe James and Mary  
here also &c. At which said next Court to witt the Eighteenth day of June and Dord. One thou-

sand seven hundred and twenty eight Comer againe as well the aforefoe James and Mary his wife &c  
as afore or the aforefoe Mary Taylor Counterpart as afore by their attorney's afore, and the same Mary  
Taylor by her said attorney as before defend the same and Injury when he and saith that he cannot  
gainsay the aforefoe Declaration afore, nor can he say but that the said William Bolitha in his life time  
did affince upon himselfe in manner and form as the same James and Mary above against her  
parte complained, nor but that the same William was Indebted as above and the same declaration

Therefore it is Considered by the Court here the same day and year last mentioned

Counterpart of the aforefoe William Bolitha for one hundred and thirteen pounds of tobacco their damage afore  
247 in form afore Confesse d as also two hundred and forty eleven pounds of tobacco for  
their Costs and Charges by them about their Suit in that Court Expendid to the same James and Mary by  
the Court here off them apon adjudged 40. of the goods and Chattells which were of the aforefoe William Bolitha  
at the time of his Death in the hands of the aforefoe Mary Taylor Counterpart as afore remaining to be administered
