Certain Joseph McCaster of Somerset County hath present here in Court undertaker for the said John Some  
that if in law the sd John Rider shall recover Judgment in the plea and against the sd John Some or that the  
sd John Some shall be therein found that then he the said John Some shall pay the condemnation of the  
Court thereupon a tender his body to the custody of the Sheriff of Somerset County in Satisfaction thereof  
or that he the said Joseph McCaster will do his cause for him.

And the sd John Some in his own proper person comes and defends the force and Injury whereof and  
says that he cannot give any the Esq. his action and so as against him brought nor can he say but  
that he did a wrong upon himself in manner and form as the sd John Rider above against him hath  
declared, nor but that he owes the sd John Rider the sd two pounds twelve shillings and six pence  
farthing Court money, and the declaration in all the words before Expressly Confessed

Therefore it is considered by the Court here the Eighteenth day June and Dowd One  
thousand Seven hundred and twenty eight that the sd John Rider recover against the sd  
John Some two pounds twelve shillings and six pence farthing Court money his damages and as  
also Two hundred & Eighty One . . . . . pounds of Tobacco for his costs and charges  
by him about his suite in that Part Extended to the same John Rider by the Court here of his own  
adjudged and the sd Doff in Merit do

answer unto Betty Gale of Apla that he render unto her the full and Just Sum of thirty  
Nine pounds Nine shillings and four pence half penny Court money of Maryland which  
to her he owes and unjustly Detaines & And whereupon the same Betty by Lewis  
Gale her atty saith that whereas the sd Mitchell the fourteenth day of September  
(Ann)
