And the afo Lazarus Maddox by George Darchell his attorney Causes and defendeth the force and Injury where he and grappeth leave to Imparte hereto until the next Court and he calleth it said the same day as given to the afo Elst here also

At which said next Court to wit the twentieth day of June anno Domini One thousand seven hundred and twenty seven came again as were the afo Martha Woolford by Roger Woolford her next friend as the afo Lazarus Maddox by his attorney and the said Lazarus by his said attorney or before defendant the force and Injury where he and saith that he hath her action and against him to have Eight nay because he saith that he doth not detain the mare of the afo Martha in manner and form as the pfe above against him hath complained and off this he putteth himself upon the Country and the afo Elst in like manner

Thereupon command is given to the Sherif of Somerset County, that immediately he cause to come here twelve men by whom who neither can nor recognize her because as were he of which said to except the said Sherif to wit Francis Allen Gent. Now hereat to wit the same day and year last mentioned master return that he hath here ready twelve men by his said precept he was command, and now hereafterward to wit the same day and year cause as were he afo Martha Woolford by Roger Woolford her next friend as the afo Lazarus Maddox by his attorney and the Jurors of that Jury thereto Impannelled being called likewise came to wit, William Holland, Robert Coker, Isaac Marsham, Wm Gide, Isaac Brittingham, Wm Dixon, Jno Glanville, Jno Donelson, Joseph Maffeter, Thomas East, Charles French and Wm Whittington who being duly elected tried and sworn to say the truth in the premises upon their oaths do say that the afo Lazarus Maddox doth detain the Mare from the afo Martha as the same Martha above against the afo Lazarus hath complained as

Whereof the same Martha her damages by occasion of the detaining of the afo Mare against the afo Lazarus Ought to recover, But because it is not known what Damages the afo Martha hath sustained by occasion of the detaining of the Mare afo, therefore it is commanded the said assessor County that by the tenth of November and Lawfull men of his County will or County he diligently inquire what damages the afo Martha has sustained ^{were} by occasion of the detaining of the mare and of his fees and charges by him about his Suite in that part of England and the Inquisition which there is,
