 whereas the said George Hutchins in his life time the tenth day of August Anno Domini
 one thousand Seven hundred and twenty two at Somersett County and within the Jurisdiction
 of this Court was indebted unto the same Betty in the Sum of two pounds Nine
 shillings Current money of Maryland for Divers goods wares and merchandises
 to him at his Special Instance and request before that time by the said
 Betty sold and Delivered and so thereof being indebted the said George in
 his life time afterwards to witt the said tenth day of August in the year and
 at the County and within the said Jurisdiction in Consideration hereof upon
 him self assumed and to the said Betty then and there faithfully promised
 that he when afterwards he should be hereunto Requested the said Sum
 of two pounds Nine Shillings Current money to the same Betty would well and
 faithfully Content and pay Nevertheless the said George in his life time and
 the said Thomas and Adam (to whose Execution of the last will and testament
 of the same George since his Death was in due form of Law committed) the
 promise and assumption of the said George in his life time so as and made
 little regarding and plotting and fraudulently Intending her the said Betty
 in that part craftily and subtly to defraud and Deceive neither the said George
 in his life time nor the said Thomas and Adam since his death the said Sum of
 two pounds Nine Shillings Current money unto the said Betty hath paid or her for
 it in any wise Contented altho the same to do the said George in his life time
 afterwards to witt the same day and year and the said Thomas and Adam
 since his death to witt the tenth day of November Anno Domini one thousand Seven hundred
 and twenty Seven at Somersett County and within the Jurisdiction and whereby the said
 Betty thereto Requested but they and every of them the same hitherto do have
 altogether Refused and the same Thomas and Adam the same to do still do
 Refuse whereby the same Betty says she is worn and hath Damage to the value of
 five pounds and thereof she brings this Suite & Lewis Gale of 2d degree of Esquire
