hands of any other person) if they shall be found in your Bailiwick to the value of fifteen hundred pounds of tobacco, and when you have the same attached or any part thereof the same in your custody safe Keep so that you have the same before the Justice of our County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing free the thirduuesday of August next then and there to be condemned according to Law to Satisfie unto Thomas Dashiell of twelve hundred and Eighty Six pounds of tobacco, which to the same Thomas Dashiell in our Court before our Justice at dividing free aforesaid, were adjudged for his Damages which he had by Quasion of a certain promise and assignment to the same Thomas, by the aforesaid Edward in his Lifetime made, and not performed &c. and that by Good and Lawfull men of your Bailiwick you make known unto the person or persons in whose hands you make the same attachment, that he she or they be and appear before the Justice of our County Court to be held as aforesaid to shew Cause, if any he she or they have why the same goods or Chattells Rights or Credits so attached in his her or their hands ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof had and made according to the form of the act of Assembly in such Case made and provided, if to him her or them it shall seem meet, and how you shall execute this. With that you make known unto our said Justice at the day and place aforesaid, and have you then and there this Writ Witnessed Samuel Hopkins Gent Justice of our said Court the twentieth day of June in the thirteenth Year of our Dominion &c.

All which said thirduuesday of August to witt the twentieth day of the same Month and Day. One thousand Seven hundred and twenty Eight Pounds the said Thomas Dashiell by his attorney aforesaid and the Sheriff of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writ was directed Take witt Cometh and maketh Return thereof to the Court here Endorsed in these words following viz - Attached full value in the hands of Ralph Milbourn, John White, and Archibald White, and Sumoned as Garnishees - of H<sup>on</sup>.
