Whereupon the sd Hannah Burke Executrix as ap in her own proper person comes and defends the force and Injury when so and says that she cannot gain say the Btch his action ap so as ap against her brought nor can she say but that the ap Tobias in his life time did assume upon himself in manner and form as the ap Btch above against him hath complained, nor can she say but that the said Btch ought to recover his Damages by Reason of the Non performance of the Promise and assumption ap to two thousand Nine hundred and forty six pounds of tobacco and One pound Nineteen Shillings and Nine pence Curr. money which the said Btch doth not gain say.

Therefore it is considered by the Court here that the ap Thomas Darhicle Recover against the ap Hannah Burke Executrix of the ap Tobias Burke dec. two thousand Nine hundred and forty six pounds of tobacco and One pound Nineteen Shillings and Nine pence Curr. money his Damages ap in form ap confessed as also three hundred & Twenty Nine pounds of tobacco for his Exrs and Charges against him about his estate in that part Extended to the said Thomas by the Court here of his apent ad judged of the goods and Chattels of the ap Tobias at the time of his Death remaining in the hands of the ap Hannah to be Administred if so much in her hands she hath and if so much in her hands she hath not then the Exrs to be Seized of the proper goods and Chattels of the ap Hannah, and the ap Deft in Money
