John Brown } take John Brown late of Somerset County Clerk if he should be found
in his bailwick and him should safe keep so that he might have his body
before the Justices of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset the third m^oday of August then
next to satisfy unto John Rider two pound twelve shillings and six pence farthing Curr^t money
and three hundred and two pound of t^{ob}o. which to the same Rider in the same Court at Dividing
