And whereupon the afo John Come being Present herein Comt in the custody of the Sheriff and thereupon the afo John Come at the prayer of the afo John Rider by his attorney afo, is by the Court committed into the custody of the afo Sheriff there to remain until the afo John Rider of his damages afo be fully satisfied &c. Whereupon the afo Sheriff being Present here in Court took charge of the afo Dr. Come according to —

hands of y<sup>r</sup> afo Mary Should thereafter happen to come to be Administred and  
when you have the same so made or any part thereof the same in your  
custody safe keep, so that you have the same before our Justices of our  
Co: Court of Somersett to be held at Dividing Creek w<sup>t</sup> third Tuesday of August  
Next to Satisfie the afo Archibald of the Debt & Damages afo whereto the is  
Convict & have you then & there this Writ Witness —

At which said third Tuesday of August to witt the Twentieth day of the same  
Month and Year one thousand Seven hundred and twenty eight comes the afo  
Archibald Smith by Lewis Hale his attorney afo the Sheriff of Somersett County to  
Whom the foregoing Writ was Directed Likewise comes and makes return thereto to  
the Court here Endorsed in these words following vizt — By virtue of the within Writ to  
me directed I wedst to y<sup>r</sup> within named Mary Woodcraft who refused to pay me any  
goods or chattels of y<sup>r</sup> decd within named in her hands & further alledged that she had  
not now nor at any time had any goods & chattels y<sup>r</sup> of same if any are by her sold & kept out  
of sight so as I may find none within my Balywick whereon to levy the debt & cost within men-  
tioned so answers —
