The same - Henry Ayres son of Henry Ayres late of Somerset County deceased is affi-
liated to own present bound by the Court unto Nathaniel Hopkins until he arrives
The same - to the age of Twenty one years; he being fourteen years years of age
the said Henry Ayres to serve his said Master the first term of time as in such lawfull Service as
he should employ him in or about during the term aforesaid. In consideration of which Servitude
the sd Nathaniel Hopkins undertakes to Learn his said apprentice during his Servitude the
trade of a wheelwright, and to Read well in the Bible, and write and cypher as far as the like
of three, and give him a set of tools, as is sufficient for the trade aforesaid and at the Beginning
of his Servitude to give him a new suit of Cloathes, and Likewise find and provide for his
Said apprenticeship during the term aforesaid meat drink washing Lodging and Cloathing sufficient
for such an apprentice to have and wear £100 -

Whereupon it is Ordered by the Court that the said Nathaniel Hopkins give good
Security for so longe with the Covenants aforesaid Wherupon the said Nathaniel Hopkins
with Johnson Hill his security both present herein Court acknowledged themselves to owe
and Dutly indebted unto the sd Henry Ayres in the summe and just sum of twenty pounds Sterl-
ing of their good and chareller land or tenement for the use of the said Henry Ayres his heirs or
as may be made and levied if default be made in the condition hereunder written -

The condition of the above Recognition is such that if the above bound Nath.
Hopkins doe well and truly Learn the sd Henry Ayres the trade of a wheelwright and to
Read well in the Bible and write and cypher as far as the like of three during the term aforesaid;
and at the Beginning of his servitude give his said apprentice a set of tools sufficient for
the trade aforesaid, and a new suit of Cloathes, and Likewise to find and provide for his said appren-
tice meat drink washing Lodging and Cloathing sufficient for him to have and wear during the
term aforesaid then the above Recognition to be void Otherwise £100 -
