Whereupon it is ordered by the Court that the said Mathew Hopkins give Security to comply with Covenants afo, and that John Scarbrough deliver up unto the said Mathew Hopkins all the Estate of the sd Harrison Ayres that he hath in his hands lett it be of what kind soever, and further it is ordered that the said Mathew Hopkins take the said Estate into his care, and the same to deliver unto the sd Harrison Ayres when he shall arrive at full age to receive the same &c

Whereupon the sd Mathew Hopkins with Johnson Hill his Security both present herein Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves to owe and stand Justly indebted unto the sd Harrison Ayres in the sum of twenty pounds stov. good and Lawfull of England of their goods and Chatters Lands and tenements severately to be made and Levied for the use of the sd Harrison Ayres his heirs and assigns if default be made in the condition hereunder written -

The Condition of the above Recognizance is such that if the above bound Mathew Hopkins do and shall well and truly learn the sd Harrison Ayres the trade of sawwheel wright and read well in the bible, and write and Cypher as far as the rule of three during his servitude afo and at the Expiration thereof to give him a sett of wheelwrights tooles, and a new suite of Cloathes and likewise find and provide for his said servant sufficient meat drink washing Loging and Bathing during his servitude afo Then the above Recognizance to be void otherwise &c

In consideration of which servitude the sd Mary Nicholson undertakes, for to learn the said Lettice Nailor to Knitt sew and Spin, and other house wifery, and likewise find and provide for her ^{said servant} meat drink washing Loging and Bathing mete for her to have and wear during her servitude afo &c

Sibb negro Girl of Mr Edmund Hough is adjudged by the Court to be twelve years of age &c

Sepio negro boy of Mr Edmund Hough is adjudged to be of the Age of eight years &c

Coston negro Boy of Samuel Hopkins Junr is adjudged by the Court to the age of ten years &c

Whereas a certain Mathew Ayres son of Henry Ayres dec. an Orphan being foolish and not any person to take care of him &c. Wherefore it is ordered by the Court that John Scarbrough take the said Mathew Ayres and his Estate into his care, and find and provide for him such Necessaries as is sufficient for him to have and wear &c
