of his goods & chattels lands, or tenements to be made and levied especially for  
the use of his said Lordship his heirs & successors if default be made in the condition here-  
under written -

The condition of the above Recognizance is such that if the  
above bound Ioseph Thompson do and shall make his personal appearance before the Justice  
of his said Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of  
March next, and answer unto his said Lordships concerning all such Matters and things as shall  
be then and there objected against him on his said Lordships Behalfe, and do not depart the  
same Court with License thereof, and stand and abide the Judgment of the Court thereupon -  
then the above Recognizance to be void 1728 otherwise 1728
