Thereupon the ad Thomas Walker with the ad Reverend Thomas Fletcher his security present here in Court acknowledged themselves to owe and stand Justly Indebted unto the ad Robert Chambers in the sum of twenty pounds good and Lawfull money of England upon the goods and Chattels Lands or tenements of for the use of the ad Robert Chambers his heirs or assigns Joyfully and Severally to be made & levied if default be made in the condition hereunder written -

The condition of the above Recognizance is such that if the above Thomas Walker do and shall during the servitude of the ad Robert Chambers learn him the trade of Shopper and to read well in the bible, and find and provide for his said apprentice during his servitude meat drink washing Laying and Bathing then the above Recognizance to be void & otherwise &c.
