bound to per person discharge the ap. Robert Chambers from out of his servitude ap.  
Thomas Walker and the said Robert Chambers being present hereon Court, is bound by the same  
Court unto Thomas Walker until he arrives to the age of twenty One year, the said Rob.  
Chambers to serve the ap. Thomas Walker the full term of time ap. in such lawfull service had  
and compelled wherein as he shoud employ him in or about ap. In consideration of which  
service, the ap. Thomas Walker undertakes to learn the ap. Robert Chambers the trade of  
a cooper and to lead well in the Bible during his servitude ap. ap. -

Whereupon it is ordered by the Court that the ap. Thomas Walker give good  
Security for to comply with the covenants ap. ap. -

Whereupon the ap. Thomas Walker  
with the ap. Reverend Thomas Fletcher his security present here in Court acknowledged him  
selfe to owe and stand Justly indebted unto the ap. Robert Chambers in the sum afforewarded  
good and lawfull money of England upon Raze their goods, and chattels Lands or tenements or  
for the use of the ap. Robert Chambers his heirs or assigns dounly and severally to be made &  
levied if defauult be made in the condition hereunder written -

The condition of the above Recouerance is such that if the above Thomas  
Walker do and shall during the servitude of the ap. Robert Chambers learn him the trade of Cooper  
and to lead well in the Bible, and find and provide for his said apprentice during his servitude meat  
drink washing Lodging and Walking then the above Recouerance to be void otherwise he -
