ship concerning all such matters & things as shall be objected against her ^{and his} _{the}
said Lordships ^{rebut} to stand & abide the judgement of the Court thereupon ^{doe not deport} _w
Court without leave thereof then this Recognizance to be void

At which said third tuesday of June to wit the twenty sev day of the same month and Dowd
One thousand seven hundred and twenty seven Jane the said Margt. Lindow here into Court and pray
that her appearance may be recorded to save her selfe and security from the above recognizance
of said Dowd and for as much as no person appeared to prosecute on behalfe of the Lord
Proprietor aforesaid, whereupon the said Margt. Lindow appearance is recorded and she and her
Security accordingly discharged £50
