the County, and that he be taken V^o, whereupon the said George Beaton is discharged
paying the fees due by reason of the premises ad V^o. Whereupon it is ordered by the Court
that the ad George Beaton take care of the child ad begett of the ad Hannah Noble, he and
present here in Court promise to do. V^o
