Content and pay never the less the said Isaac his promise and assumption as in form as made not regarding but plotting and fraudulently Intending him the same Robert in that part craftily and Subtly to defraude and Deceive the said Isaac, the said Sum of Six pounds seven shillings and six pence or any part thereof to the same Robert he hath not paid, altho' the same to doe the said Isaac afterwards viz. the same day and Year as and within the said Jurisdiction by the same Robert was Requested but he the same hither to, to doe, hath altogether Refused and still doth Refuse whereby the same Robert says he is worse and hath Damage to the value of three pounds Curr. money and there of he brings this suite &c. I hale pray god of mee.

As to the said Isaac Teston in his own proper person comes and defends the true and injury whereof and says that he cannot deny the action as of the said Robert, nor but that he did assume upon himselfe in manner and form as the said Robert above against him hath Complain'd, and as to the Damages of the same Robert, by reason of the premises, in that part sustained, the same Isaac says and Confesseth that the said Robert sustained by Damage by reason of the premises besides his Costs and Charges by him about his Suit in that part Expended to One pound Seventeen shillings and six pence Currant money, and noe more, and because the said Robert deny's not this but the same allegation Confesseth pray Judg^t and his Damages above Confesed together with his Costs and Charges as to him adjudged &c.

Therefore by Consent of the Parties as it is Considered that the said Robert Boyer recover against the said Isaac Teston his Damage as to One pound Seventeen shillings and six pence Curr. money as by the same Isaac in form as Confesed as also two hundred & ten pounds of tobacco for his Costs and Charges as to the same Robert at his Request by the Court here and Consent of the parties as Adjudged which Damage in the whole do amount to One pound Seventeen shillings & six pence Curr. money & two hundred & ten pounds of tobacco and the said Isaac in Mercy &c.
