At the same time and place Cap<sup>t</sup>. George Dushier aged thirty seven years or thereabouts deposed on the holy Evangelist of almighty God that he being Clerk to the Commissioners for laying out white Haven Town in Somerset County on Wicacumoc River in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & seven saith that where a cedar post now stands by the Edge of a marsh behind a house formerly belonging to Cap<sup>t</sup>. George Gale about forty two foot from the bank of the River above mentioned and in a line drawn South twenty six degrees East to the brink of the first turn of a Creek called Dushier Creek alias Walkers to the best of his knowledge was the place where at uppermost or North boundary of Lot N<sup>o</sup>. six in the Town aforesaid stood and further saith not. The above deposition taken before us on the Lot above mentioned in presence of these Party's Concerned the Day and Year above -

We the Subscribers do hereby certify that Cap<sup>t</sup>. Geo<sup>rge</sup> Dushier Esq<sup>r</sup>. Merrett Esq<sup>r</sup>. being both present at white Haven Town in Somerset County on the Lot N<sup>o</sup>. three mentioned in a Commission to us directed bearing date as above, did unanimously agree in our presence that a cedar post that was Wicacumoc River side being the lower most southwest boundary of a Lot of the aforesaid Town N<sup>o</sup>. <sup>three</sup> was the first boundary of said Lot and that the said Lot should run from the first boundary aforesaid to wit the above mentioned post, South sixty six degrees East eighteen pole, thence north East six pole thence North sixty six degrees west Eighteen pole thence South west to the first boundary. Given under our hands this 31<sup>st</sup> day of July 1728.

Judge Justice of our said Court &c. On the Back side of the foregoing Commission It was thus Endorsed viz<sup>t</sup>.
