 Hannah Burke of
 Tobias Burke - - - and Chattels which were of Tobias Burke late of Somerset County decd
 in the hands of Hannah Burke Eschering of the last will and testament
 of the ap Tobias Burke being in his bailiwick he should make three thousand and ninety
 six pounds of tobacco and one pound sixteen shillings and nine pence current money that aforesaid
 Thomas Dashiell by the County Court of Somerset before the Justices there of a dividing Bench
 were adjudged for his damages which he had by reason of aforesaid promise and assumption
 to the same Thomas by the ap Tobias in the County ap, in his life made and not performed if
 the ap Hannah hath so much of the goods and Chattels which were of the ap Tobias at the
 time of his death in her hands, remaining to be administered, and if the ap Hannah hath not so
 much, then the Justices to be seized of the proper goods and Chattels of the ap
 Hannah to satisfy the ap Thomas of his damages ap, where ~~the~~ ^{the} is found.
