The Condition of a<sup>th</sup> Recognizance is Such that if the above bound David Burgin shall well and truly make his personall appearance before his Lordships Justice of the peace for Somerset County at about to be held at Dividing Creek in said County the third Tuesday of June Next ensuing the Date hereof and there to answer unto his said Lordships Concerning all such Matters and things as shall be then and there objected against him or his said Lordships behalfe and do stand and abide of Judgment of the Court thereupon and do not Depart the Court without Leave thereof then this Recognizance to be void &
