Be it Remembered that upon the eighth day of May Amd.
Ichn. follo. I. Dated one thousand Seven hundred & twenty seven before us came John Galloway of St. J.

County Wexford with William Etman of the same place Plaster his Security.

And acknowledged themselves to owe and stand truly indebted unto the Lord Proprietary
of His Province in the sum of Sixty pounds Sterl of their goods and Chattels, lands
and tenements Separately to be levied from & due of the said Lord Prop. his heirs &
successors if default be made in the condition hereunto annexed.

The Conditions of which Recognizance is Sunk that if the above named John
Galloway shall well and truly make his personal appearance before his Lordships
Justices of the peace for Somerset County at a court to be held at Dodington Hatch in St. J.
County the third Tuesday of June next ensuing the date hereof having there to answer
his said Lordships concerning such matters and things as shall be knowne there objected ag
him on his said Lordships behalfe and do stand and abide by judgment of the Court thereupon
if you do not Depart the Court without leave thereof then this Recd. to be void &c
At which said third Tuesday of June to wit the twentyninth day of the same
month Anno Domini one thousand Seven hundred & twenty seven same day the said John
Galloway appearance is recorded and he and his Security accordingly discharged &c

Martin Fenlon appears according to his Recognizance entered into to give Evidence against
Margrett Syders and was discharged therefrom &c

Charles Ballard appears according to his Recognizance entered into to give evidence against
Margrett Syders and was accordingly discharged therefrom &c

Richard Blundett appears according to his Recognizance entered into to give Evidence
against Peter Filgerrell, and is accordingly discharged therefrom &c

Benjamin Debrace appears according to his Recognizance entered into, to give evidence
on behalf of the Proprietary against David Burgh and is discharged therefrom &c
