Testis. John Donelson - On the Back side of the foregoing Bill
of Indictment it was thus Endorsed viz - True Bill. Geo. Scott. Foreman

Thereupon Command was given to the Sher. of Somerset County that he should take the
said Mary Barwick if he to answer &c. and afterwards in the same Court some the said
Mary Barwick under Custody of the said Sher. into whose Custody before that time was
committed for the cause aforesaid, and being by the said Sher. brought to the bar, and having
heard the Indictment aforesaid, she says that she is not guilty of the felony and as by the
Indictm. aforesaid, is upon her Imposed, Whereupon the Court here values the said Gold Necklace
and Lockett in the Indictment aforesaid mentioned to Nine hundred and Eighty pounds of tobacco.

Therefore it is considered by the Court that the said Mary Barwick pay unto the
said John Donelson the fully deprived four fold of the value of the Necklace and Lockett and
amounting in the whole to three thousand Nine hundred and Twenty pounds of tobacco, and that
the said Mary Barwick be whipt with thirty nine lashes on the bare Back well laid on until
the blood appear, and that she stand in the pillory one hour, and that she be taken &c. and
thereupon as to the Corporal punishment aforesaid Command is given to the Sher. of Somerset
County that he do thereof Immediate Execution according to the Indictm. aforesaid Rendered by
whipping of the said Mary Barwick at the publick whipping post with thirty Nine Lashes on the
bare Back well laid on until the blood appear and by sitting her in the pillory one hour -
afterwards in the same Court the Sher. returns that he has done the Execution of the Indictm.
aforesaid as to the Corporal Punishment and he was Commanded. whereupon the said John Donelson
master of the said Mary Barwick present hereto Court undertakes for to deliver up & unto Somerset
County, Court or Sher. of said County At the Expiration of her servitude the said Mary Barwick to
Recompence to said County the fees due by Quorum of the felony and &c. -

John Donelson appears according to his Recognizance Entered into, to give Evidence against Mary Barwick and
is discharged

His Lordship } Robert Scott appears according to his Recognizance Entered into for his good behavior
and appearance at this Court, for to answer a breach of his Lordship's Peace made by
him upon a certain Ach-sah Lawrence, and is discharged therefrom, and is ordered
by the Court to give new Recognizance with One Security each in ten pounds Sher. for his good behavior
and
