The condition of this Recognizance is such that if the above bounden Robert Scott do and shall make his personall appearance before the Justices of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be hold at Dwiding Creek the third Tuesday of June next, and answer unto his said Lordship concerning all such matters and things as shall be then and there objected against him on his said Lordship's behalf and do not depart the same Court without Licence thereof and in the meantime to be of the good behavior toward all his Lordship's good people and more especially toward the aforesaid Achsah Lawrence, then the above Recognizance to be void and of none effect otherwise.

Whereupon the aforesaid Achsah Lawrence in her proper person present herein Court

acknowledged herself to owe and stand Justly indebted unto his Lordship the right honorable the Lord proprietor in the sum of five pounds good and lawfull money of England of her goods, Chattle, lands, or tenements for the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors to be made and levied if default be made in the condition hereunderwritten.

The condition of this Recognizance is such that if the above bounden Achsah Lawrence do make her personall appearance before the Justices of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be hold at Dwiding Creek the third Tuesday of June next, and then and there give Evidence on behalf of his said Lordship against Robert Scott, and do not depart the same Court without Licence thereof then the above Recognizance to be void otherwise.
