At Robert Grewen's Command was given to the Sher^{iff} of Somerset County that he should be

 and him should safe keep so that you have his body before the Justices of his Lordship's County
 Court of Somerset to be hold at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of March then next to answer unto Robert Grewen of England
 of trespass upon the case &c. and that thereof he should not fail &c.

And the said Robert Grewen by Francis Allen his attorney declared against the aforesaid Joseph Hall in the
 plea as follows &c.

Somerset County Joseph Hall late of Somerset County Clerk was attached to.
 answer unto Robert Grewen of England of trespass upon the case &c.

And whereupon the said Robert by Francis Allen his attorney complains that whereas the said Jos.
 the thirteenth day of September One thousand Seven hundred and twenty six at Somerset County within the Jurisdiction
 of this Court was indebted unto the said Robert in ten pounds Court money of Maryland as by amount hereunto.
 annexed and herein court produced may appear and being so thereof indebted the said Joseph in consideration
 thereof the day and year aforesaid at the County aforesaid upon himself did assume, and to the said Robert then &
 there did faithfully promise that he the said Joseph the said Ten pounds, to the said Robert when he should
 be thereunto Requested he would well and faithfully pay and content and altho' the said Joseph four pounds
 of the said Ten pounds to the said Robert he hath paid and satisfied yett as to six pounds remain-
 ing and fraudulently Intending the said Robert in that part faithless and slyly to deceive and defraud.
 the said six pounds to the said Robert altho' the same to do the said Joseph by the said Robert on the aforesaid
 thirteenth day of September in the year as and often afterwards at the County as he was thereunto Requested hath
 not paid or to him for the same in any wise contented, but the same to him to pay or in any wise for the same to
 content hath hitherto altogether Refused and still doth Refuse and deny whereupon he saith he is worse and
 hath damage to the value of twelve pound money aforesaid and thereupon he brings suite &c.
