

Hale that if in law the said Robert Grews shall recover Judgment in the plea aforesaid against the aforesaid Joseph Hale or that the said Joseph shall be therein convicted, that then he the said Joseph Hale shall pay the condemnation of the Court thereupon or Render his body to the custody of the Sheriff of Somerset County in satisfaction thereof or that he the said Thomas Coniter will do it for him -

Whereupon the afo Joseph Hale in his own proper person comes and defends the force and Injury when asked and says that he cannot gain say the action aforesaid of the afo Robert, nor but that he did assume upon himself in manner and form as the afo Robt above against him that he complained, and as to the damages of the same Robert by him by occasion of the premises in that part sustained, the same Joseph says and confesseth that the afo Robt has sustained damage by occasion of the premises besides his costs and charges by him about his suit in that part expended to six pounds four money, and because the aforesaid Robert denies not this, but the same allegation confesseth to be true, prays Judgment and these damages above confessed together with his costs and charges aforesaid to him adjudged &c -

Therefore by consent of the parties aforesaid, it is considered that the aforesaid Robert Grews Recover against the aforesaid Joseph Hale his damages afo, to the afo six pounds four money &c. Maryland by the same Joseph in form aforesaid confessed, as also two hundred and eighty eight pounds of tobacco for his costs and charges, to the same Robert at his request by the Court here, by consent of the parties afo adjudged, which for said damages in the whole do amount to six pounds four money of Maryland and two hundred and eighty eight pounds of tobacco, and the aforesaid debt in money &c -

AND whereupon the said Archibald by Francis Allen his attorney complains that whereas the said David the twenty third day of December one thousand seven hundred and twenty eight at Somerset County within the Jurisdiction of this Court was indebted unto the said Archibald in three pounds fifteen shillings and four pence four money of Maryland as by account herunto annexed and here in Court produced may appear and being so thereof indebted the said David in consideration thereof the day and year aforesaid
