as also two hundred and eighty seven pounds off tobacco for his costs and Charges to the same Archibald
at his request by the Court here and Consent of the parties and adjudged which certain damages in the whole
do amount to three pounds twelve shillings and four pence current money of Maryland and two hundred and
eighty seven pounds off tobacco and aforesaid debt in money &c. —
