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then and there faithfully promised that she when afterwards she should be thereunto requested she the aforesaid sum of five hundred pounds of tobacco, to the same Riggini would well and faithfully content and pay. Never the less the said Elizabeth Standley her promise and assumption aforesaid in form aforesaid made not regarding but plotting and fraudulently intending like the same Riggini in that part fraudulently and seditiously to deceive and defraud the aforesaid Standley the aforesaid sum of five hundred pounds of tobacco, or any part thereof to the same Riggini hath not paid altho. the same to do the aforesaid Standley afterwards bid. the same day and year as at the County of and within the aforesaid Jurisdiction by the same Riggini was requested but the same hitherto to do hath altogether refused and still doth refuse whereby the same Riggini says she is worse and hath damage to the value of one thousand pounds of tobacco and thereof she brings this suite &c. —
