attys afo<sup>d</sup>, and thereupon the same Andrew by his attorney afo<sup>d</sup> prays that the said Margaret  
Waile may give security for costs in case his wife may be obtained against her in the plea aforesaid  
which is by the Court granted. Whereupon a certaine Lewis Hale of Somersett County Gentleman present
