And the sd William Hopkins by George Deshire his attorney comes and defend, the force
and Injury when &c. and praye leave to imparle hereunto untill the next Court and he hath
it and the same day is given to the sd Bly here also &c.

Att which said next Court to witt the fifteenth day of August and Dowd One thousand seven-
hundred and twenty Eight came again as well the sd Hocken Hull shorl by his attorney ad as
the sd William Hopkins by his attorney ad, and the sd William Hopkins by his said attorney
as before defend, the force and Injury when &c. and saith that he cannot gain say the action ad
of the sd Hocken Hull, neither can he say, but that he was Bailiff of the sd Hocken Hull
of the Mollasse and Sugar ad, by the time ad, neither can he say, but that he ought to account
with the aforesaid Hocken Hull of the time that he was Bailiff and receiver of the same in form
ad, as the said Bly above against him ^{saith} Complain'd &c.

Therefore it is considered that the sd William Hopkins account with
the sd Hocken Hull shorl of the time that he was bailiff and receiver of the same Hocken Hull
and hereupon Isaac Morry, John Donelson and James Martin all of Somerset County
beare are assigned Auditor by the Court here, to hear the said account, which said Auditor or
any two of them to make their award between the parties ad and make their return to
next Court, and the same day is given to the sd Bly and doth here also —

Att which said next Court to witt the Nineteenth day of November and Dowd One
thousand seven hundred and twenty Eight came again as well the sd Hocken Hull as the
sd William by their attorney ad, but the sd Auditor return not their award in the pre-
mises ad between the parties ad, therefore further day is given, to the sd Bly and doth
here untill the next Court to hear the award of the sd Auditor in the premises ad —

Att which said Next Court to witt the Eighteenth day of March and Dowd One thou-
sand seven hundred and twenty Eight came again as well the sd Hocken Hull as the sd
William by their attorney ad, and hereupon John Donelson and James Martin two
of Auditor ad mentioned make their award in the premises ad between the
parties ad, which follows in these words viz. By vertue of a Commission to us directed bear-
ing date the 23: day of November: 1728 and having Inspected the severall accounts and
Certificates here said before us we doe not find that the within named William Hopkins is
any ways Indebted to the within named Hocken Hull shorl as witt of our hands and Seals
