Hull shant take nothing by his writ afo^d, but be thereof in mercy for his false Humour and that the said Mr.
Hogkins goe therof without day &c and also it is considered that the afo^d William Hogkins recover against the afo^d
Hocken Hull shant two hundred and Seventy Nine - pounds of tobacco for his lights and Candles by him
about his defense in that suit sustained to the same William by the Court here of his afo^d account according to the
form of the Statute thereof lately made and provided adjudged, and that the afo^d Mr have hereof his Execution
done.

Ios Miffler - - - "memorandum" the Begr by Lewis Hale his attorney sued out his Ldship's writ afo^d
attachment against the debt, the tenour of which will follow in these words.
Lewis Hale and Joseph Venable Garnishee of ~~the~~ ^{Mr} D^r Somerset for Charles absolute Lord and Proprietary
Andrew Wailes - - - of the provinces of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c.

To the Sher^t. of Somerset family greeting, wee command you that you attack any the goods
Chattels lights and credits of Andrew Wailes late of Somerset County merch^t. if they shall be found in your
Cailyw^t to the value of four thousand pounds of tobacco, and when you have the same attached or any
part thereof the same in your custody safe keep so that you have them before the Justice of our County
Court to be held at Davidding Beck the third Tuesday of March next then and there to be condemned
according to act of Assembly to and for the use of Captain Joseph Miffler unless the said Andrew
Wailes by himselfe or his attorney shall appear and answer unto the said Joseph Miffler of a greate
offence upon the case &c according to law, and that by good and Lawfull men of your Cailyw^t
you make known unto the person or persons in whose hand you made the same attachment that
he she or they be and appear before the Justice of our County Court to be held as afo^d to shew cause if
any he she or they have why the same goods (Chattels lights or credits) so attached in his her or their hand
ought not to be condemned and spent whereof had and made according to the form of the act of
Assembly in such case made and provided if to him her or them it shalbe shewn mete, and how you
spend this writt, that you make known unto our said Justice at the day and place afo^d and
you then and there this writt witness Samuel Hogkins Gentleman &c -

At which said third Tuesday of March to wit the Eighteenth day of the same month and day
One thousand Seven hundred and twenty eight being the day of the return of the said Writ
Joseph Miffler by his attorney afo^d and the Sher^t. of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writt was directed
likewise cometh and maketh return thereof to the Court here bidded and -

Attached full value in the hands of Mr Joseph Venable and Mrs Lewis Hale and sumoneth
all Garnishees to shew cause if any they have &c before Hutton Hill and for his full credit good and law:
if any man of my Cailyw^t so answers I do^t kno^t ^{it} -

And wherupon the afo^d Joseph Venable by Lewis Hale his attorney saies and says that he cannot
saye but that he has of the Rights and Credits of the said Andrew Wailes to the value of twelve
pounds six pence and eleven pence Sterling money of England, nor but that the same ought to be
condemned in his hands for the use of the said Joseph Miffler as of the Rights and Credits of the said
and^w Wailes which the said Begr doth not gainsay -

Also the afo^d Lewis Hale garnishee of the afo^d Andrew Wailes appears in his own proper person
