And Whereupon the aforesaid William Merchant in his own proper person Cometh and defendant the free and injury wherein &c and sayth that he cannot deny the action aforesaid of the aforesaid George Tute nor but that he Owe the same George the aforesaid One thousand three hundred and twenty six pounds of tobacco in manner and form as the aforesaid George above against him hath declared &c

Therefore it is Considered that the aforesaid George Tute recover against the aforesaid William Merchant One thousand three hundred and twenty six pounds of good sound Merchantable meat to be paid his debt aforesaid and his damage by reason of the detaining of the same debt to two hundred & four pounds of tobacco to the same George of his agent by the court here adjudged and debt in mercy &c

Hutton Hile - Somerset County.

John Bishop late of Somerset County planter otherwise John Bishop - Called John Bishop of Somerset County in the province of Maryland planter was Summed

to answer unto Hutton Hile of agen that he render unto him One thousand pounds of good sound merchantable pork which to him he Owe and unjustly detain to him &c

And whereupon the said Hutton by Francis Allen his attorney saith that whereas the aforesaid

John the eighth day of August One thousand seven hundred and twenty eight at Somerset County agreed within the Jurisdiction of his Court by his certain writing Obligatory which the said Hutton with the Seal of the said John the seal of the obligation signed hereunto Court being the date whereof is the same day and year did acknowledge himself to be bound unto the said Hutton in the aforesaid One thousand pounds of good sound merchantable pork to be paid to the said Hutton when he should be thereto required yet the said John tho' often required the said One thousand pounds of pork to the said Hutton hath not render'd but the same to him hitherto to render hath denied and still doth deny and unjustly detain to the damage of the said Hutton of five pounds curr. money and thereof he brings suit to

And the said John Bishop in his own proper person Cometh and defendant the free and injury wherein &c and sayth that he cannot gainsay the action aforesaid of the aforesaid Hutton nor but that the writing Obligatory aforesaid is his act and deed, nor but that he Owe the aforesaid Hutton the aforesaid One thousand pounds of pork in manner and form as the aforesaid Hutton above against him hath declared &c

Therefore it is Considered that the aforesaid Hutton Hile recover against the aforesaid John Bishop One thousand pounds of good Merchantable pork his debt aforesaid and his damage by reason of the detaining of the same debt to two hundred and sixteen pounds of tobacco to the same Hutton by the court here of his agent adjudged and the aforesaid debt in Mercy &c
