and firmly bound unto Robert Collins orphans of Thomas Collins dec'd in the sum  
and just sum of twelve pounds sixteen Shillings and eight pence to be paid to the said per-  
son or persons her Executors Administrators or Assigns, to the which payment well and truly to be  
made we bind us, and every one and every of our heirs Executors and adm'ts. Diversly and  
severally in aid for the whole family by these presents sealed with our Seals and dated the 21<sup>st</sup> day  
of April anno Dom. 1729. The condition of the above Obligation is such, that wherea-

the said Commissioner General hath transmuted into this Court the amount of the Estate of  
Thomas Collins dec'd. wherein it is found that there is due to the above said Orphans the sum  
of six pounds eight Shillings and four pence; therefore the said Thomas Collins John-  
Evans or Martin Kenett or any of them or either of their heirs Executors or Administrators  
shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Orphans the said sum of six pounds  
eight Shillings and four pence, to be paid her according to act of Assembly in such case made  
and provided when the said attains at full age to receive the same & then the above Obligation  
to be at full force and vertue - - -
