fort Collins her Executors Administrators or assigns, to the which payment well and truly to be  
made we bind us, and every of us our and every of our heirs Executors and admrs. Joyntly and  
severally in and for the whole family by these presents sealed with our Seals and dated the 21<sup>st</sup> day  
of April and Bond. 1729

The condition of the above obligation is such, that whereas  
the said Comynsary General hath transmitted unto this Court the amount of the Estate of  
Thomas Collins dec. wherein it is found that there is due to the abovesaid Orphan the sum  
of six pounds eight Shillings and four pence; if therefore the said Thomas Collins John-  
Evans or Martin Kennett or any of them or either of their heirs Executors or Administrators  
shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Orphan the said sum of six pounds  
eight Shillings and four pence, to be paid her according to act of assembly in such case made  
and provided when she shall attain at full age to receive the same &c. then the above obligation  
to be of full force and virtue
