Ordered by the Court that Margaret Waile pay unto John Tilman One hundred and eighty pounds of tobacco
being due unto him for his attendance, six days as Evidence, for the said Margaret Waile against Andrew
Thompson he having made Oath to the same &c.

Ordered by the Court that Margrett Waile pay unto James Souger Sixty pounds of tobacco being due unto him
for his attendance two days as an Evidence for the said Marg' Waile against Andrew Thompson he having made
Oath to the same &c.

Ordered by the Court that Marg' Waile pay unto David Maddox Ninety pounds of tobacco being due
unto him for his attendance as an Evidence ^{three days} for the said Marg' Waile against Andrew Thompson he having
