further it is covenanted and agreed upon by and Between the said Master and Servant that  
the said Master is to find and provide for his said Servant during his servitude ~~the~~ all  
meat drink washing Lodging and Cloathing Mote for such a servant to have and wear

Ordered by the Court that John Winders be Overseer of Road in Stead of James Bowcher

Ordered that Robert Collier be a road from the Bridge at the head of Tiggwin to followage tree
