that the said sum of five pounds Eighteen shillings and six pence he would wear and truly content and pay when he should be thereto requested Nevertheless the same James his promise and assumption and in form and made Little regarding but plotting and fraudulently Intending the same Alexander in that part to defraud the same he hath not paid nor in any way contented, but the same to pay hath refused and still doth refuse to the said Damage of the said Alexander twelve pounds Current money of Maryland and thereof he brings this Suit & Damages of Dues. Elders & Costs for

And whereas the said James Jones by in his own proper person Jones and defends the force and Injury when &c. and says that he cannot gain say the action aforesaid of the said Alexander, nor but that he did assume upon himself in manner and form as the said Alexander above against him hath complained and as to the Damage of the same Alexander by him by occasion of the premises in that part sustained by occasion of the premises besides his Costs and Charges by him about his Suit in that part expended to five pounds Eighteen shillings and six pence, and because the said Alexander deny's not this but the same allegation confessed to be true, pray Judgment and those Damages above confessed together with his Costs and Charges as to him adjudged &c.

Therefore it is considered by consent of the parties and that the said Alexander Drager Recover against the said James Jones his Damages as to five pounds Eighteen shillings and six pence by the same James in form and confessed as also two hundred and Twenty eight pounds of tobacco for his Costs and Charges as to the same Alexander at his request by the Court hereof and Consent of the parties as adjudged which certain Damages in the whole do amount too ~~two hundred and~~ five pounds Eighteen shillings and six pence and two hundred and twenty eight pounds of tobacco and the said James in Money &c.
