 Whereupon the aforesaid Philip Taylor so before warned and at the same day  
 being solemnly called Cometh not but makes default

Therefore it is considered that the aforesaid James Dickerson have Execution against  
 the aforesaid Philip Taylor of the aforesaid seven hundred and thirty four pounds of tobacco his damages  
 aforesaid by default, Likewise the aforesaid James Dickerson according to the form of the Statute  
 in such Case lately made and provided Recover against the aforesaid Philip Taylor two hundred & thirty  
 212 three . . . . . pounds of tobacco for his costs and Charges and damages which he sustained  
 by reason of delay of Execution of the damages aforesaid by pretext of the writ of Privilege  
 aforesaid here by the Consent of the aforesaid James Dickerson heard &c.

Mr. John Tunstall - Command was given to the Just. of Somerset County that he should  
 take Richard Hubbard late of Somerset County mariner if he should  
 be found in his Bailiwick and him should safe keep so that he might  
 have his body before the Justice of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at  
 dividing Bench the third Tuesday of June then next to answer unto John Tunstall of a plea  
 of trespass upon the Case &c. and that thereof he should not fail &c.  
 At which said third Tuesday of June to wit the seventeenth day of the same month and  
 Year One thousand seven hundred and Twenty Nine being the day of the return of the said writ  
 Cometh the said John Tunstall for his own proper person and the Just. of Somerset County  
 to whom the foregoing writ was directed Likewise Cometh and maketh return thereof to the Court  
 here endorsed viz. Copy of John Tunstall's plea -

And the aforesaid Richard Hubbard by Francis Allen his attorney Comes and defends the force  
 of injury when &c. and offers himself against the aforesaid John Tunstall in the plea aforesaid but the  
 said John Tunstall altho' solemnly called Cometh not, Nor is his writ against the aforesaid Richard  
 Hubbard further prosecuted &c.  
 Therefore he and his pledges of Execution be in mercy, let  
 the said John Tunstall name the pledges, and that the aforesaid Richard Hubbard give thereof without  
 delay, also it is considered that the aforesaid Richard Hubbard Recover against the aforesaid John Tunstall  
 his damages by reason of the premises to one hundred & forty three . . . . . pounds of tobacco  
 to the said Richard by direction of the Justice here as his request for his costs and Charges in that  
 part sustained according to the form of Statute &c. by the Court here adjudged &c.

Mr. William Bratton - Command was given to the Just. of Somerset County that he should take  
 Tobias Cooper late of Somerset County planter otherwise called Tobias  
 Cooper of Somerset County if he should be found in his Bailiwick and  
 him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justice of his Lordships  
 County
