at the same day returned that he by virtue of the writ aforesaid to him directed he had made known to the aforesaid Philip Taylor by Jacobus Arabia and Solomon Townsend honest and lawfull men of his daily work aforesaid, to be before his said Lordships Justices at the day and place aforesaid to have & do within to him it was commanded.

Whereupon the aforesaid Philip Taylor so before warned and at the same day being solemnly called witness not but marked default

Therefore it is considered that the aforesaid James Dickerson have Execution against the aforesaid Philip Taylor of the aforesaid Seven hundred and Thirty four pounds of tobacco his damage and by default, Likewise the aforesaid James Dickerson according to the form of the Statute in such case lately made and provided Recover against the aforesaid Philip Taylor two hundred & Thirly two pounds of tobacco for his costs and charges and damage which he sustained by occasion of delay aforesaid upon the damages and by present of the writ of Execution, and here by the Consent of the aforesaid James Dickerson taxed £0

Mr. John Taintor - Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take Richard Hubbard late of Somerset County mariner if he should be found in his daily work and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justice of his Lordships County of Somerset to be held at Bridgwater the third Tuesday of June then next to answer unto John Taintor of a plea of herps upon the castle and that thereof he should not fail £0 -

At which said third Tuesday of June to wit the Seventeenth day of the same month and Anno Domini thousand and Seven hundred and Twenty nine being the day of the return of the said Writ Cometh the said John Taintor for his own proper person and the Sheriff of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writ was directed Likewise witness and marketh return thereof the Court here endorsed viz: Ep: Cor: & John Burnside Jsd -

And the aforesaid Richard Hubbard by Francis Allen his attorney comes and defends the same injury wherein £0 and offers himself against the aforesaid John Taintor in the Glebe aforesaid the said John Taintor altho' solemnly called witness not, nor is his writ against the aforesaid Richard Hubbard further prosecuted £0

Therefore he and his plenger of Prosecuting be in mercy, let the said John Taintor name the plenger, and that the aforesaid Richard Hubbard goe thereof without day, also it is considered that the aforesaid Richard Hubbard Recover against the aforesaid John Taintor his damage by reason of the premises to One hundred & forty three - - pounds of tobacco to the said Richard by direction of the Justices here as his request for his costs and charges in that part sustained according to the form of Statute £0 by the Court here adjudged £0.
