County Court of Somerset to be held at Bridgwater Creek the third Tuesday before Michaelmas next to answer
unto William Bratton of Aggleham Rector unto him thirty pounds current money of Maryland -
which to him the Owe and did unjustly detain ^{do} -

Aid the aforesaid William Bratton by Francis Allen his attorney declared against the said Tobias
Begger in the plea of as Holloway's suit. Somerset County b. & Tobias Begger late of Somerset
County Blantyre otherwise called Tobias Begger of Somerset County was summoned to answer unto
William Bratton of Aggleham that he render unto him thirty pounds current money of Maryland which to him
he owe and unjustly detain ^{do}. And whereupon the said William by Francis Allen his attorney came
that whereas the aforesaid Tobias the twenty sixth day of August One thousand Seven hundred and twenty
Eight at Somerset County aforesaid within the jurisdiction of this Court by his certain Writing Obligatory -
which the said William with the seal of the said Tobias signed hereunto Court brings the date whereof is
the same day and he did acknowledge himself to be bound unto the said William in the aforesaid -
thirty pounds money aforesaid to be paid to the said William when he should be thereto required
yet the said Tobias tho often required the said thirty pounds to the said William hath not rendered
but the same to him hitherto, to render hath denied and will do the same and unjustly detain to the
damage of the said William of ten pounds money aforesaid and hereof he brings suit ^{do}.

Francis Allen Esq. Plaintiff vs. Tobias Begger

Copy of the foregoing declaration was made and sent to be served on the defendant with
the writ in the place aforesaid - At which said Court to wit the seventeenth day of the
June month anno domini One thousand Seven hundred and twenty Nine being the day of the return of
the said Writ came the said William Bratton by his attorney aforesaid and the Recd. of Somerset County
to whom the foregoing writ was directed likewise comette and marketh return thereof to the Court here
followed in these words following bid for signs of declaration delivered in due form sealed and filed.

Whereupon the aforesaid Tobias Begger being called appear, and thereupon the said Tobias Begger
at the prayer of the aforesaid William Bratton by his attorney aforesaid is adjudged to give special
bail to the action aforesaid but for want whereof the said Tobias Begger is committed into the custody
of the Sheriff of Somerset County there to remain ^{do}.

And afterwards in the same Court came a certain Robert Scott of Somerset County farwainer and
undertaker for the said Tobias Begger, that if in case the said Tobias William Bratton shall recover
judgement in the place aforesaid against the aforesaid Tobias Begger or that the said Tobias Begger
shall be herein found that then he the said Tobias Begger shall pay the judgment of the Court
thereupon or render his body to the custody of the Sheriff of Somerset County in satisfaction thereof
or that the said Robert Scott will do it for him.

And the aforesaid Tobias Begger in his own proper person came and defend the same by saying -
whereas and say that he cannot have any action aforesaid of the said William; nor but that the
writing Obligatory ^{do} is the fault of the same Tobias nor but that the same William the
aforesaid thirty pounds in manner and form as the aforesaid William above against him hath declared

Therefore it is considered that the aforesaid William Bratton Recover against the aforesaid Tobias Begger
thirty pounds current money his debt and his damages by reason of the detaining of the same debt
to three hundred & fifty eight - - - pounds of £100 to the same William of Maryland
The Court here adjudged and the aforesaid debt is hereby ^{do}
