of Great Britain to be paid the same John Tunstall when afterword the same John Bidell should be there to  
Requested yett the said John Bidell tho' often thereto required the said sum of four hundred pounds Sterling  
money of Great Britain, to the same John Tunstall hath not rendered but the said John Bidell the same  
hitherto to do hath altogether denyed and thereto deny and unjustly detain whereby the same John  
says he is worse and hath damage to the value of thirty five pounds ster. and thereof he brings this writing  
and the same John Tunstall brings here into Court the writing Obligatory and which the debt ad in form ad  
doth testify whose date is the same day and year ad Levin Gale Esq. Esq. of the Dock Roe.

Whereupon the said John Bidell being called appears and thereupon the said John Bidell at the  
Prayer of the aforesaid John Tunstall by his attorney ad is adjudged to give special Bail to the action  
ad, but for want thereof the said John Bidell is committed into the custody of the Sher. of Somerset County  
here to remain. The said Sher. to witt John Burnell Gent. present herein Court took charge  
of the said John Bidell accordingly, thereupon day is given unto the said John Bidell in custody as ad until  
the next Court and the same day is given to the ad Esq. here also &c

At which said next Court to witt the nineteenth day of November and Dow One thousand seven hundred  
and twenty eight came against the said John Tunstall by his attorney ad, and thereupon further day is given to  
the aforesaid John Bidell in custody as ad until the next Court and the same day is given to the ad Esq. here also &c

At which said next Court to witt the Eighteenth day of March and Dow. One thousand seven  
hundred and twenty eight came againe as well the ad John Tunstall by his attorney ad as the ad John  
Bidell in custody as ad by Francis Allen his attorney, and the ad John Bidell in custody as ad by his  
said attorney comes and defend the force and injury when &c. And pray the hearing of the writing  
obligatory ad it is read unto him &c. he also pray the hearing of the condition of the same writing & it is  
read unto him in these words viz. The condition of y<sup>e</sup> above Obligation is such that if y<sup>e</sup> above bound  
John Bidell him his heirs Ex. or assigns do keep Indemnified y<sup>e</sup> above said Tunstall of an action of  
a certain Patrick Macknight of the Island of Bermuda which said action is carried on by his  
attly Capt Robert Gordon now hath y<sup>e</sup> above John Bidell under an arrest for whose appearance  
y<sup>e</sup> above John Tunstall is bound as also to answer y<sup>e</sup> Debt & all charges that may thereupon  
beon provided y<sup>e</sup> said Robert Gordon obtains judgment against y<sup>e</sup> said Bidell Now if y<sup>e</sup> above bound  
John Bidell do keep y<sup>e</sup> above John Tunstall clear of all Dam. whatsoever relating to y<sup>e</sup> said  
action according to the true intent & meaning thereof then y<sup>e</sup> above Obligation to be void otherwise to  
remain in full force & Virtue in y<sup>e</sup> Law which being read & heard y<sup>e</sup> said John Bidell saith y<sup>e</sup>
