Summons against the sd Rhoda Bowen whereof followeth in these words viz.
Somersetts Charles absolute Lord and Proprietary of the provinces of
Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c To the Just. of Somerset County hearing whereat
Jos: McCarter lately in our City Co: of Soudeth here to witt the twenty first Day of March
One thousand Seven Hundred & twenty Six before Saund. Hopkins Gent & his associates then
Justices of our said Co:, at Dividing Creek by Consideration of y^e same Co: recovered against
Rhoda Bowen late of Soudeth Co: y^e Widow One thousand five hundred Eighty three ^{of}
of tob: for his Dam: which he sustained by Occasion of a certain promise & assumption to
the same Jos: by y^e afo Rhoda made & not performed, whereof she is Convicted by the
Record & process thereof in our same Co: before our Justices at Dividing Creek remain-
ing Manifestly appeareth. Now the l^{ts} Execution of y^e Judgmt: afo as yett remaineth
to be made as by the Insinuation of y^e afo Jos: we have received, because we are willing
that those things which in our same Co: are rightfully done should be duly executed. You
maide you that by Good & Lawfull Men of your Parish you make known unto y^e
afo Rhoda Bowen that she be, before our Justices of our City Co: of Soudeth to be held at
Dividing Creek, y^e third Tuesday of June next to show Cause if any thing for herselfe she
hath or knoweth to say wherefore y^e afo Jos: his Execution against her of y^e Judgmt: afo ought
