

Att which was third Tuesday of June to wit the seventeenth day of the same month and then one thousand seven hundred and twenty nine, before his Lordship's Justice of the peace for Somerset County at dividing Creek Cometh the said Joseph Maulester by his attorney aforesaid, and the shew. of the County aforesaid to wit John Burnall Gent. at the same day returned that he by virtue of the writ aforesaid to him directed had made known to the said Rodah Bowen by Edward Franklyn and William Cunnett of honest and lawfull men of his Bailiwick that she be before his Lordship's Justice at the day and place aforesaid to shew. as to him it was commanded, whereupon the said Rodah Bowen so before warned, and at the same day being solemnly called Cometh not but makes default

Therefore it is considered that the said Joseph Maulester have Execution against the said Rodah Bowen of the damages aforesaid according to the force form and effect of the recovery aforesaid and that the said Joseph Maulester, according to the form of the Statute in such case lately made and provided recover against the said Rodah Bowen two hundred and six - - - - - pounds of tobacco for his costs charges and damages sustained by occasion of delay of Execution of the damages aforesaid by pretext of the writ aforesaid here by consent of the said Joseph Maulester taxed so afterwards the same day and year the said Joseph Maulester present herein first in his proper person and afterwards himself to be satisfied of six hundred and eighty one pounds of tobacco part of the damages aforesaid therefore the same Rodah Bowen of the said six hundred and eighty one pounds of tobacco part of the damages aforesaid be quiet &c.

Memorandum the 18th by Levi Gale his attorney sued out his Lordship's Execution against the debt the tenor whereof followeth in these words to wit

 City Greeting Whereas Jos. McCarter lately in our City of Southwell here to wit the fifteenth day of March One thousand seven hundred & twenty five before said Hopkins Gent. his associates than Justices of our said City at dividing Creek by force of a certain writ recovered against Tobias Lepper late of Southwell City Sheriff nine hundred & sixty two pounds of tobacco for his dam. which he sustained by occasion of a certain promise or assumption to y^e said Jos. by y^e said Tobias fatal, made & not performed whereof he is convicted as by the record & process thereof in our said City before our Justices at dividing Creek remaining manifestly appears the never the less Execution of the Judgment aforesaid yett remaineth to be made as by the Jurisdiction of y^e said Jos. we have received & because we are willing that these things which in our said City are lawfully done should be duly executed, Command you that by honest & lawfull men of your Bailiwick you make known unto y^e said Tobias Lepper that he be, before our Justices of our City of Southwell to be holden at dividing Creek y^e third Tuesday of June next to show Cause if any for himselfe he hath or knoweth to say wherefore y^e said Jos. his Execution against him of y^e Judgment aforesaid ought not to have according to y^e form of y^e recovery aforesaid, into him it shall be y^e Expedient leave you then & there the names of them by whom to him you make the same known & this writt with the said Hopkins Gent. Chief Justice of our said City
