the said Matthew Tilghman Ward in our same Court were led judged for his costs  
& Dam: which he Had by Occasion of the Detaining of the same Debt whereof  
he is Convict as by the record & process thereof in our same Co: before our Justices  
at Dividing Creek remaining Manifestly appeareth Nevertheless Execution of the  
Judgmt: add as yett Remains to be Made as by the Insinuation of the aforesaid Matthew  
Tilghman Ward we have Received, and because we are willing that those things which in our same  
Court are light fully done ought to be duly Executed. Comand you that by honest and Lawfull  
men of your Barlywick you make known unto the said Nathaniel Horsey that he be before our  
Justices of our County Court of Somerset to be hold at Dividing the third Tuesday of June next  
to shew Cause if any thing for himself he hath or to say knoweth, wherefore the said Matthew  
Tilghman Ward his Execution of the debt and Damages add he ought not to have according to the  
form of the Recovery add if to him it seemeth Expedient and have you then and there the
