Judgm<sup>t</sup>: to Henry Fitzwaters for the Sum of two thousand  
five hundred <sup>and fifty</sup> pounds of tobacco which sum was recovered <sup>by the said Henry Fitzwaters</sup>  
against

the said Jos: M<sup>r</sup> Lester on the seventeenth Day of June in Somerset  
County: the said two thousand five hundred & fifty pounds of tobacco to  
be levied of your Body's goods or Chattels Lands or tenements for use of the said  
Henry Fitzwaters in case the said Jos: M<sup>r</sup> Lester shall not pay & Satisfie to the said Henry  
Fitzwaters the said two thousand five hundred & fifty pounds of tobacco so as aforesaid recover-  
ed against him with the Additionall Costs thereon <sup>on the 15<sup>th</sup> Day of Feby<sup>r</sup> next</sup>

De it Remembred that this day to witt the Eighteenth day of

June One thousand seven hundred and twenty nine came into Court George Dashiell  
Gent of the Indiments of this County for the right hon<sup>ble</sup> the Lord Proprietary of this province that  
now is & gives the Court to understand & to be informed that a certain Robert Scott late of allhallowes -  
Parish in Somerset County Blanton on the fourteenth Day of April last did owe one thousand seven hundred  
& twenty nine with some Armes & at the parish of in the County within the Jurisdiction of this Court in payment  
of a certain Deborah Lawrence in the peace of God your said Lord proprietor then & there being an assault  
made her did Beat wound & Cruelly treated so that of her Life it was in danger & other Harms to  
her then & there did do to the Great Damage of the said Deborah Lawrence & against the peace  
of your said Lord proprietor his Good Will & Dignity wherefore your said Geo: Dashiell for our S<sup>ds</sup> Lord pro-  
prietor pray Advise ment of the Court here in the premises that due Process of Law may issue  
& Dashiell for our Lord prop<sup>r</sup>.

Thereupon Command was given to the Sher<sup>iff</sup> of Somerset County that he should take the said Robert  
Scott if he to answer & and afterwards to witt the seventeenth day of June and one thousand  
seven hundred and twenty nine before our Justices here at dividing Creek in Somerset County Cometh the  
aforesaid Robert Scott in his proper person, and after hearing of the Information afo<sup>r</sup>, thereupon  
he says that he is not guilty thereof and of this he puts himself upon the County, and George Dashiell  
who for his said Lordship in this behalf follows likewise, and afterwards the said Robert Scott in his  
own proper person present here in Court ~~pro~~ Relinquisheth his Verification afo<sup>r</sup>, says that he is  
guilty of the trespass and assault afo<sup>r</sup> above upon him imposed &c.

Wherefore it is considered by the Court that the said Robert Scott be taken Satisfie his said  
Lordship of his fine by Quasion of the trespass and assault afo<sup>r</sup>, which same Robert Scott, then and there  
present in Court afo<sup>r</sup> prays that he may be admitted, at fine with his said Lord King by Quasion afo<sup>r</sup>  
and thereof he puts himself in mercy of his said Lordship, and the fine of the same Robert Scott by  
the Justices afo<sup>r</sup> is assessed to five hundred pounds of tobacco to the use of his said Lordship

Thereupon the said Robert Scott is discharged from his recognizance entered  
into to answer as aforesaid and is ordered to give new recognizance for his good behaviour and  
appearance at next Court. Whereupon the said Robert Scott with John Boye his Security  
both present here in Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves to owe and be  
indebted
