at the sum of Nine pounds fifteen shillings and five pence halfe Penny he would well and truly
Content and pay when he should be thereunto requested Nevertheless the said William his promise
and affumption aforesaid in form aforesaid made not regarding but continuing him the said Gabriel to deceiveth
defraudeth and sum of Nine pounds fifteen shillings and five pence halfe Penny current
money of Maryland he hath not paid this aforesaid hereto requested but the same to do hath defrauded
and vouchsafed to the damage of the same Gabriel of twenty pounds like money and
hereof he bringeth this suit.
