Jos. Muffeter — was attacked to answer unto Henry filz watere afo're aplea of his debt upon the  
Case &c And whereupon the same Henry by George Dashwood his attorney complaines  
that whereas the same Joseph Muffeter the tenth day of November One thousand seven hundred and  
twenty seven at Stepney parish in Somerset County afo' within the jurisdiction of this Court was indebted  
unto the same Henry in the sum of two thousand five hundred pounds of tobacco as by note under  
the hand of the same Joseph may appear and the same Joseph being indebted afo' in consideration  
afo' at the time and place afo' did upon himself assume and promise that the afo' sum of two thousand  
of five hundred pounds of tobacco he would well and truly content and pay when he should be thereupon  
so required, nevertheless the same Joseph by his promise and aumpnment afo' in form afo' made little  
regarding but plotting and fraudulently deterring him the said Henry to receive the said sum of two  
thousand five hundred pounds of tobacco he hath not paid but the same to pay hath delayed and still  
doth delay to the damage of the said Henry off five thousand pounds of tobacco and theretothe

And the afo' Joseph Muffeter by Lewis Hale his attorney comes and defend the same  
Injury, when &c and says that he cannot gainsay the action afo' of the afo' Henry, nor but that he did  
assume upon himself in manner and form as the afo' Henry above against him hath complained and as to  
the damage of the same Henry, by him by occasion of the premises in that part sustained the same Jos.  
says and confesseth that the afo' Henry has sustained damage by occasion of the premises besides his costs  
and charges by him about his suit in that part amounted to two thousand five hundred pounds of tobacco  
and not more, and because the afo' Henry denys not this but the same allegation confesseth to be true  
prayd judgment and those damages above confessed together with their costs and charges afo' to him adjudged £
