 selves to owe and stand Justly Indebted unto the said Henry Freaders in the sum of twenty pounds
 Sterling good and Lawfull money of England of their Goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements
 Jointly and Separately to be made and Levied for the use of the said Henry Freaders if default
 be made in the Condition hereunder written.

The Condition of this Recognizance is such that if the above bounden Johanna
 Hugg do and shall well and faithfully learn the said Henry Freaders during his servitude the trade
 of Sawearing and to read well in the bible and find and provide for her said servant meat drink washing
 Lodging and apparel make for such a servant to have and wear &c
