Memorandum the 15th by George Dashiell his attorney sued out his Lordships
writ of Habeas Corpus against the defendt. the tenor whereof followeth in
these words vizt. Somerset p. Charles absolute Lord and propri-
:etary of the provinces of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore

To the Sherr. of Somerset County Gent. Greeting Whereas John Howman lately in our County
Court of Somersett hereto with the nineteenth day of March one thousand seven hundred and twenty seven
before Samuel Hopkins Gent. and his associates then Justices of our said Court at Dividing Creek
by Consideration of the same Court recovered against John Lipholt late of Somersett County in the
province of Maryland Midwight six pounds Tennant money and three hundred and eight pence
of Tobacco for his Damages which he sustained by Breach of aforesaid promise and assumption to the
said John Howman by the said John Lipholt lately made and not performed whereof he is Convinced
as by the Record and Process thereof in our same Court before our Justice at Dividing Creek remaining
manifestly appeareth upon the Testimony of the Judges. and as yett Remains to be made as by
the Insinuation of the said John Howman we have received and because we are willing that those
things which in our said Court are lawfully done should be duly executed, Command you that by
honest and Lawfull men of your Bailly which you make known unto the said John Lipholt that
he be, before our Justices of our County Court of Somersett to be hold at Dividing Creek the third
tuesday of August next to show Cause if any for himselfe he hath or knoweth to say wherefore
the said John Howman his Breach against him of the Judges. and ought not to have awarding
to the form of the recovery and if unto him it shall seem Expedient and have you then and
there the Names of them by whom to him you make known and this writ Witness our selves Samuel Hopkins
Gentleman Chief Justice of our said Court the nineteenth day of June in the first year of our

Dominion &c. At which said third tuesday of August to with the nineteenth day of the same month one
one thousand seven hundred and twenty seven before his said Lordships Justice of the County Court
of Somersett at Dividing Creek Cometh the said John Howman by his attorney and the Sherr. of
Somerset County vizt. John Barnard Gent. by Verule of the Writ of to him directed made known
to the said John Lipholt by ^{Grace} Martiale and Robert Deal honest and Lawfull men of his Bailly-
:wick that he be before his said Lordships Justice at the day and place and to show &c. as above
to him it was commanded, and the aforesaid John Lipholt so before warned and at the same day
