To the Sher. of Somerset County Genteel Greeting Whereas John Howman lately in Our County
Court of Somerset here to with the nineteenth day of March One thousand seven hundred and twenty seven
before Samuel Hopkins Gentleman and his associate then Justice of Our said Court at Dividing Court
by Consideration off the same Court recovered against John Lightfoot late of Somerset County in the
Province of Maryland Millwright six pounds Current money and three hundred and eight pounds
of tobacco for his damages which he sustained by reason of a certain promise and engagement to the
same John Howman by the said John Lightfoot lately made and not performed whereof he is bound
as by the Record and Proofs thereof in Our same Court before our Justice at Dividing Court remaining
manifestly apparent notwithstanding Execution of the Judgment as yet remanente to be made as by
the Indemnition of the said John Howman we have received and because we are willing that those
things which in Our said Court are lightly done should be duly treated, command you that by
honest and Lawfull men of your County with you made known unto the said John Lightfoot that
he be before our Justices of Our County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Court the third
Tuesday of August next to shew cause if any for himself he hath or knoweth to say wherefore
the said John Howman his Execution against him off the Judgment as ought not to have according
to the form of the Recovery and if unto him it shall seeme expedient and have you then and
here the names of them by whom to him you make known and his will witnessd Sommell Hopkins
Gentleman Gentle Justice of Our said Court the Nineteenth day of June in the fiftteenth year of Our
Dominion 1729.

All which said third Tuesday of August to with the Nineteenth day of the same month and
one hour and Seven hundred and twenty nine before his said Lordships Justice of the County Court
of Somerset at Dividing Court shew the said John Howman by his attorney and the Sher. of
Somerset County to the John Curman Gentleman by virtue of the Writ and to him directed made known
to the said John Lightfoot by Marlate and Robert Deale honest and lawfull men of his County
which shall be before his said Lordships Justice at the day and place and to shew what answere
